Vascular Plants of New Hampshire

This list of New Hampshire plants was compiled by Gilbert George (George 1997). It began with The Flora of New England (Seymour 1969) but it includes information from other published sources and the author's own field work. There are about 1,500 native and 500 naturalized plants in the list. "Naturalized" plants are non-native but persist and reproduce successfully outside of cultivation. "Not naturalized" plants are generally species that escape from cultivation but, without human help, are not expected to persist.

This list is a careful compilation of the flora of New Hampshire, but should be considered a beginning rather than a final product. Seymour's Flora, the foundation of this list, was based largely on collections at Harvard University through the late 1960s. Gil George has expanded Seymour's Flora with his own findings, but the list does not reflect recent plant collections of other botanists, or vouchered collections at local herbaria (including Hodgdon Herbarium at the University of New Hampshire). NH Heritage considers this list to be very close to a complete list, but it is not yet comprehensive. We have made the following changes to the original list from Gil George:

- (1) We have revised names of rare species, where necessary, to match the taxonomy used by NH Heritage. We have not completely reviewed the list in light of current taxonomic treatments.
- (2) Rare species have been identified based on the NH Heritage plant tracking list. Developed in cooperation with researchers, conservation organizations, and knowledgeable amateur botanists, the NH Heritage tracking list includes but is not limited to species listed as threatened or endangered under the NH Native Plant Protection Act of 1987.
- (3) Other than identifying rare species based on the NH Heritage tracking list, we have not included comments on degree of rarity (e.g. 'Common' vs. 'Frequent') from the original list. These descriptions from Seymour (1969) refer to New England rather than just New Hampshire, and while still applicable for many taxa they need to be revisited in light of more recent findings. For a current **regional** list of rare plant species in New England, consult the *Flora Conservanda* (Brumback et al. 1996).

A Quick Overview of the NH Natural Heritage Inventory's Purpose and Policies

The Natural Heritage Inventory is mandated by the Native Plant Protection Act of 1987 (NH RSA 217-A) to determine protective measures and requirements necessary for the survival of native plant species in the state, to investigate the condition and degree of rarity of plant species, and to distribute information regarding the condition and protection of these species and their habitats.

The Natural Heritage Inventory provides information to facilitate informed land-use decision-making. We are not a regulatory agency; instead, we work with landowners and land managers to help them protect the State's natural heritage and meet their land-use needs.

The Natural Heritage Inventory has three facets:

Inventory involves identifying new occurrences of sensitive species and classifying New Hampshire's biodiversity. We currently study more than 600 plant and animal species and 120 natural communities. Surveys for rarities on private lands are conducted only with landowner permission.

Tracking is the management of occurrence data. Our database currently contains information about more than 4,000 plant, animal, and natural community occurrences in New Hampshire.

Interpretation is the communication of Natural Heritage Inventory information. Our goal is to cooperate with public and private land managers to help them *protect* rare species populations and exemplary natural communities.
